

The aim of the Fyssen Foundation is to “encourage all forms of scientific inquiry into cognitive mechanisms, including thought and reasoning, which underlie animal and human behavior; their biological and cultural bases, and phylogenetic and ontogenetic development”.

The 2022 Fyssen International Prize will be awarded for research in :

**MODELLING OF COGNITIVE FUNCTION**

The Prize will reward the development of computational approaches that advance our understanding of cognitive processes

This Prize will be awarded to a scientist who has conducted distinguished research in the areas supported by the Foundation: **Ethology, Psychology, Neurobiology, Social Anthropology, Ethnology, Human Palaeontology and Archaeology.**

It is expected that the applicant would have influenced significantly cognitive sciences at the international level.

The award for the International Prize is **100 000 €**.

**The application must be submitted by a recognized scientist and include:**

- A recommendation letter,
- A curriculum vitae and a list of publications,
- A summary (four pages maximum) of the scientific achievements that justify the award.
